Following into his teen years, he discovered his passion for creating music, writing in his journals, and ordering Chinese takeout. Zachary continued to pursue his passion for music as an adult. He would record himself rapping to express himself and then, upload the songs onto the internet in hopes of one day becoming a rap star. Zachary was so determined to become a rap star that he even picked up the hobby of graphic design in order to create album covers for the music he had created. Besides his music, he enjoyed fishing, cooking, drawing, studying the Bible, and going to the Raiders game in Kansas City every year with his brother, Kanyon. Zachary touched the lives of many during his 30 years of life. He knew many people and had visited several places including living in Missouri, Texas, Wyoming and traveling to California. 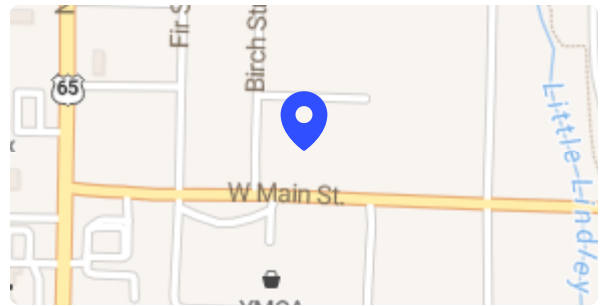
