She was a loving sister and aunt and a caring neighbor and friend. She will be missed greatly and her memory will linger on in the hearts of her family and friends.






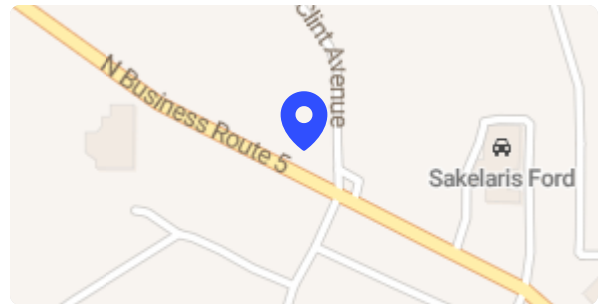

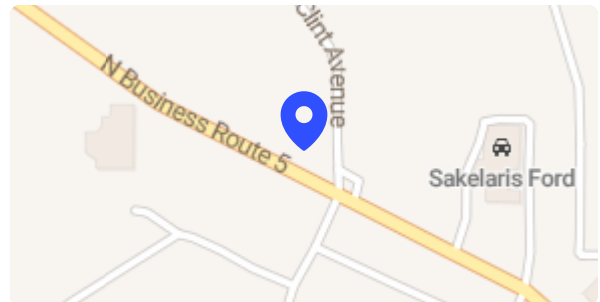

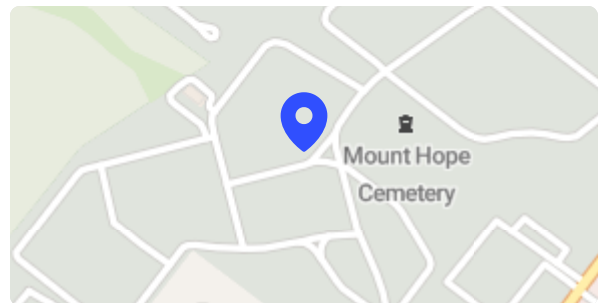
