On December 20, 1936 Claude and Martha (Ballard) Paul welcome into this world Wilberta Jane. Along with her big Sister Maggie Belle, they were the apples of their parents eyes. Even though there was a 10 year difference between the two sisters, they were extremely close and each other's best friend until Maggie's death.

On July 31, 1954 Wilberta and Roy Hulett were married and the love affair continued for more than 61 years, until Roy's passing in 2016. 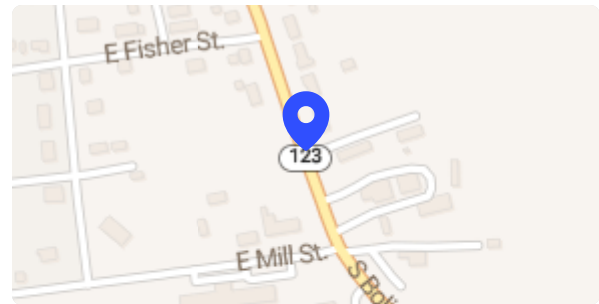
