Elsie was a loving mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and a caring neighbor and friend. We celebrate her life and will cherish the many memories we have had with her.






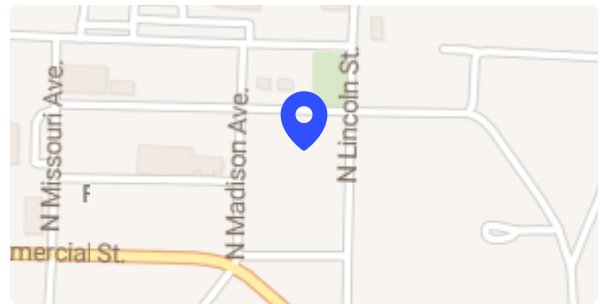
