Rev. Bobby Joe Knapp, son of Woodrow and Eva Decker Knapp, was born May 3, 1942, near Sleeper, Missouri. He was greeted by God's angels Tuesday, November 22, 2022, in his home in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty years, seven months, and twenty-four days.

On July 10, 1959, he was united in marriage to Lois F. McGuire, and to this union two daughters and one son was born.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Charlotte Anderson; and a brother, Don Knapp and son-in law, David Becker.

A memorial has been established to Hufft Cemetery and donations may be made through the funeral home.






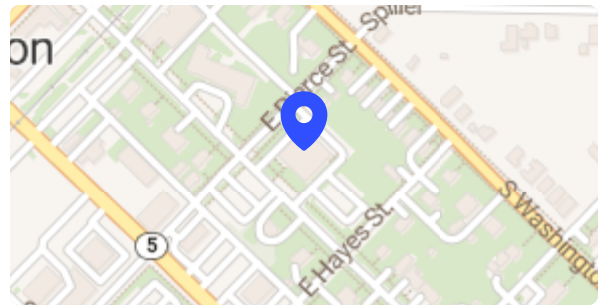

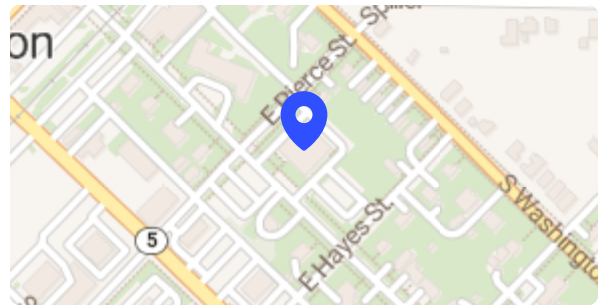

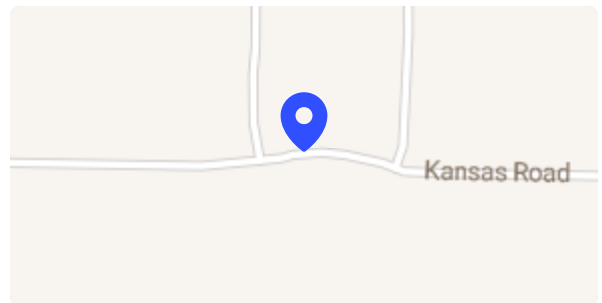
