Vester L. Williams of Lebanon, Missouri, passed away Friday, July 28, 2023 in Mercy Hospital in Springfield, Missouri. At the time of his passing he was eighty-four years, eleven months and one day of age.

Vester was born August 27, 1938 in Wright County, Missouri to Owen Williams and Ethel Jones. He was raised in Wright County and worked for Bishop Furniture. His real passion was discovered when he went in to business for himself, doing upholstery, flipping houses and fixing old cars. Memorial contributions can be made in Vester's honor to the Humane Society through the funeral home.



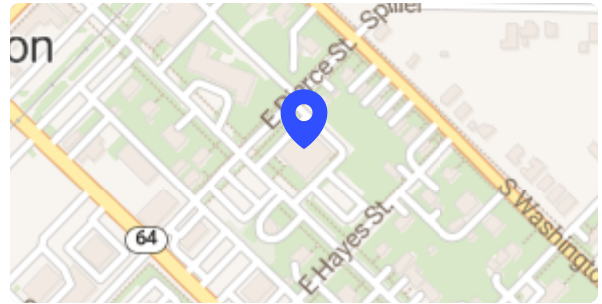

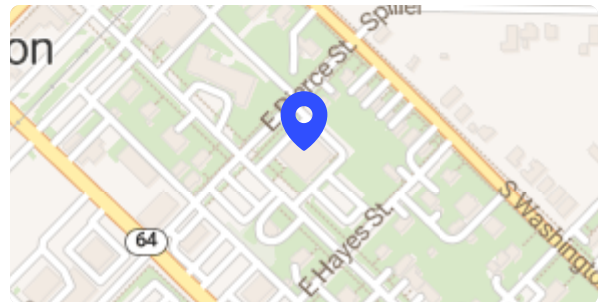

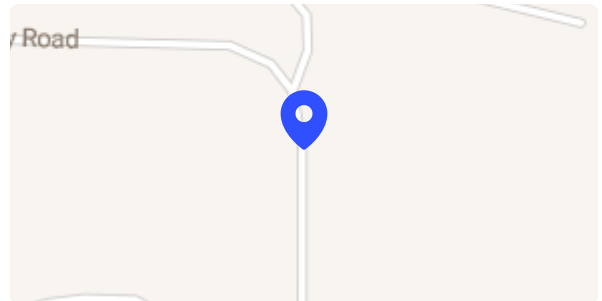
