A memorial has been established for the Lebanon Fire Department Full Fire Tribute and contributions may be made through the funeral home.






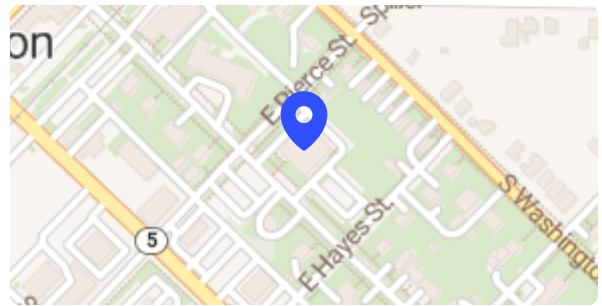

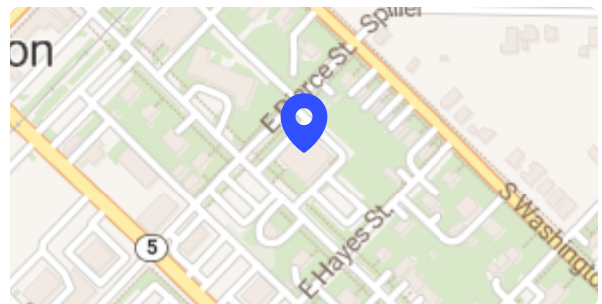

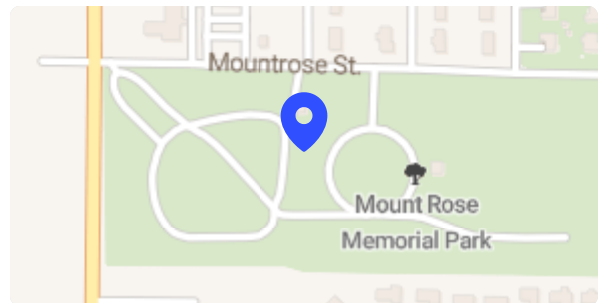
