A meal will be provided on Friday, December 8, at the Lebanon American Legion, following the service.






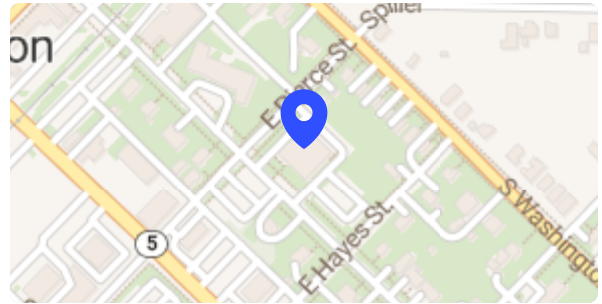

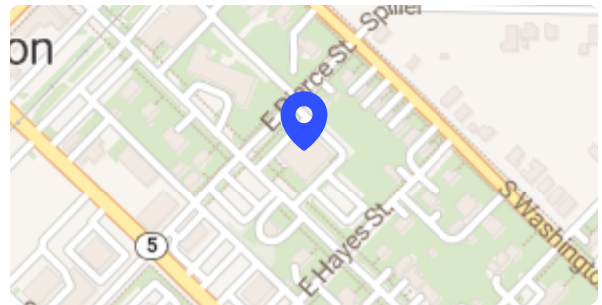

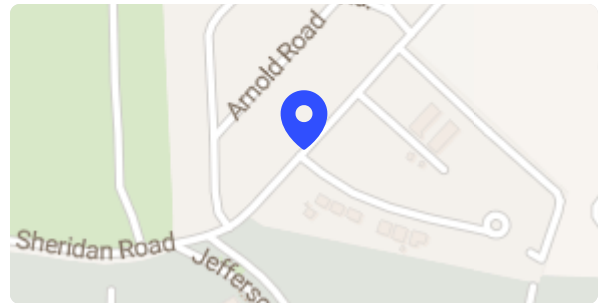
