A memorial to Ozark Community Cemetery or St. Jude Children's Hospital has been established and donations may be made through the funeral home.



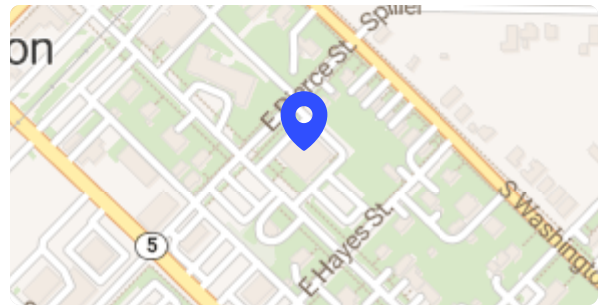

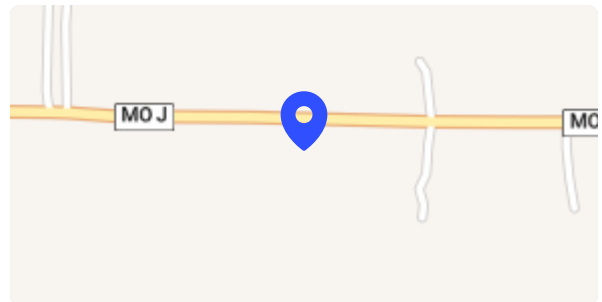

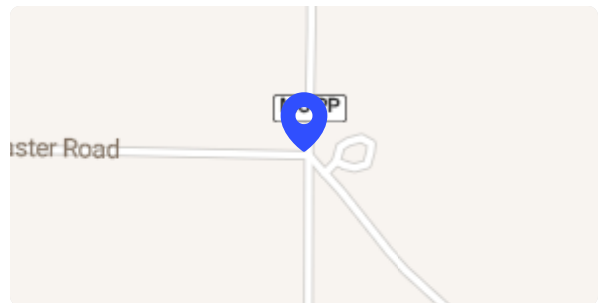
