Peggy Pauline Thorndike Moffett, 85, passed away on the 6th of March 2024, in her home.

Mom was born in Davenport, IA, on the 14th of July 1938, to Leone and Jack Thorndike. She attended Frank L. Smart Junior High School. When in high school, she chose family over school. She dropped out of school to help her mom raise some of her nieces. She later pursued and got her GED.

Mom met Jerry Moffett in 1963. They took a shine to each other and eloped on Valentine's Day, 1965. They were together for 39 years, until Dad's passing in 2004.

During our childhoods, Mom was a stay-home mom and homemaker. She loved it and we are forever grateful for that. It was during this time that she decided to try her hand at oil painting on canvas. 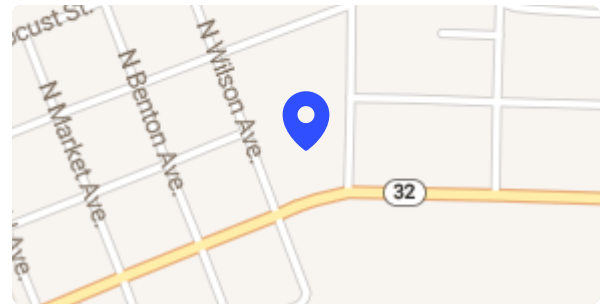

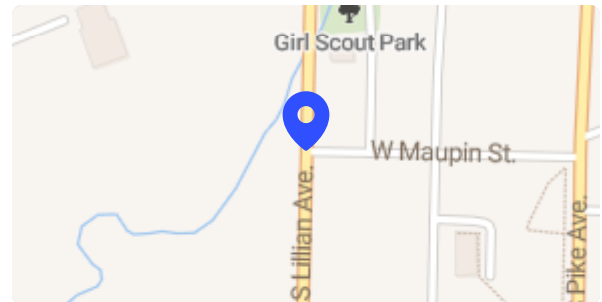

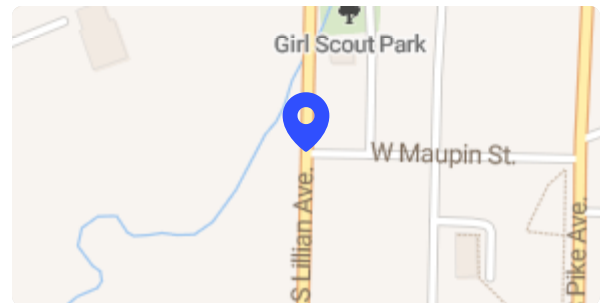
