Rubye Ann (Sherertz) Briggs was born June 5, 1922, to George A. and Sadie (Hale) Sherertz in Seymour, Missouri. She departed this world on January 7, 2013, in Ontario, California at the age of 90.

Rubye Ann was born and raised in the Seymour area. Graduating from Seymour High School she then attended Missouri Teachers College. Rubye was united in marriage to Doran Gifford Briggs on September 19, 1945 in Upland, California. To this union two children were born.

Rubye Ann was employed as a teacher at the Flint Hollow School before moving to California where she worked as a secretary at The Daily Report Newspaper. 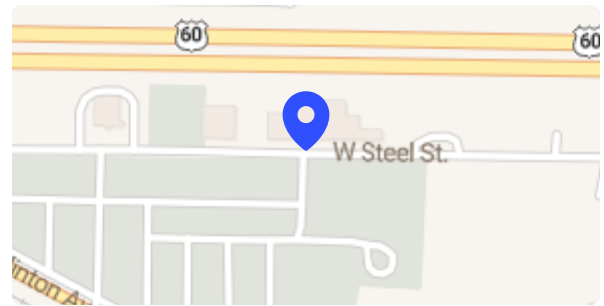
