Mr. Jackson was born on the family farm 6 miles East of Buffalo on June 10, 1935, and attended his first four years of grade school at the old "New Liberty" near the farm before the family moved to Jackson County. He graduated from High school at Drexal MO in 1952, then attended Williams Jewells College in Liberty, MO and graduated from Findley Engineering College in Kansas City, MO, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1961. He immediately started his career as a Project Engineer at Vendo Company. He received numerous awards for accomplishments in Engineering.

Mr. Jackson was baptized in 1953 into the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, now the community of Christ where he served until his death. He held several offices including the first quorum of 70 in Minnesota district and Pastor of the Orono Congregation and the Red Wing Congregation, both which he organized and established and worked with Sammy Malone and Terry Robinson to organize the Buffalo, MO Mission.
