A memorial to the Ronald McDonald House has been established and donations may be left at the funeral home.



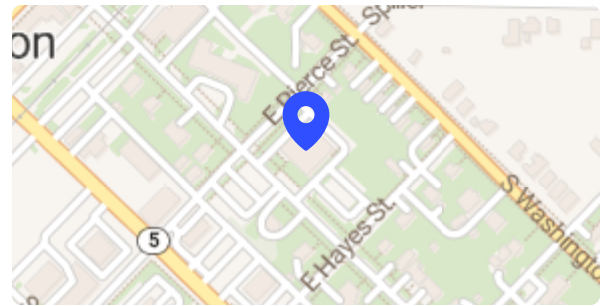

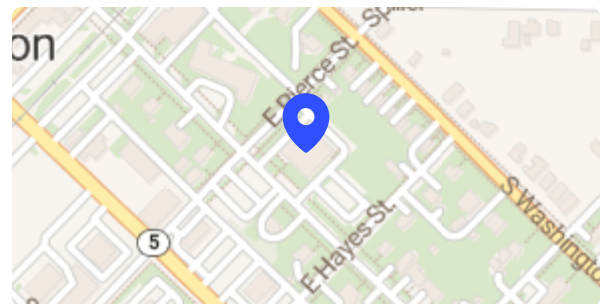

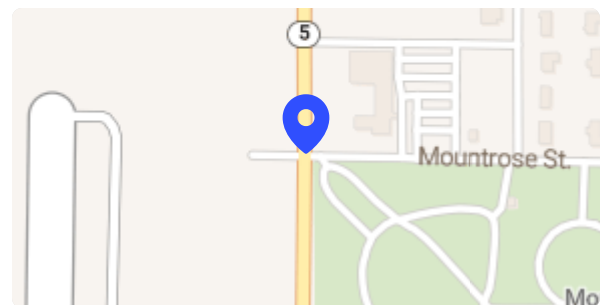
