A memorial to the family has been established and donations may be made at the funeral home. A fund has also been established at Heritage Bank of the Ozarks and donations may also be made there.



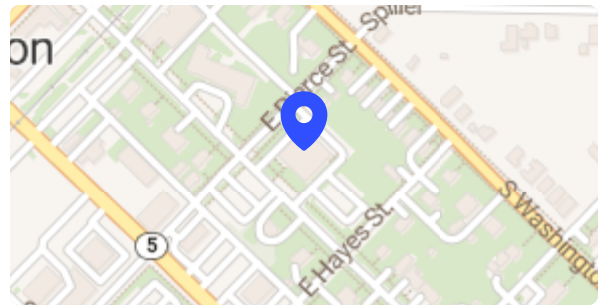
