Edward Henry Dampier, son of the late Ray & Alpha (Clemmons) Dampier, was born on August 1, 1934 and departed this life on February 1, 2021. At the time of his passing, he was 86 years of age.

Together they enjoyed attending the local ballgames, going to see a movie and traveling to the Lake of the Ozarks to Water Ski.

Edward moved to Sikeston, Missouri after he finished his degree to begin his career as a FDIC Bank Examiner. The family then moved to Springfield, Missouri and later settled on the family farm in Eldridge, Missouri in 1974.
