Harold Lee "Hal" Emerson, son of Harold G. Crum and Ann Ward Emerson, was born November 11, 1938, in San Antonio, Texas. He departed this life Thursday, February 13, 2020, in Lebanon North Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-one years, three months, and two days.
