January 4, 1939 - April 23, 2021

Mr. Thomas (Tom) Munger, age 82, of Linn Creek passed away Friday, April 23, 2021 surrounded by his family and friends with his million-dollar view of the lake. Tom was born January 4, 1939 in Omaha, Nebraska, the son of Anne (Rezac) Wehrli and Kenneth Ray Munger.
